4-15-2010 Special Reward Offered in Case of Harold Schroetter, Falcon Heights

Up to \$50,000 Reward Offered

On February 26th, 2009 Harold Schroetter, 57, went missing from his residence in Falcon Height, MN. He was employed as a postal worker in St. Paul and had never missed work for an unexplained prior to his disappearance. Harold was in the process of ending his relationship with his live-in girlfriend and changing the beneficiaries of his estate at the time of the disappearance. He was also excited as he recently found out that he was to become a grandfather. Authorities located Schroetter's red Chrysler under suspicious circumstances in the area of Arlington Ave and Jackson St. in St. Paul on March 1st, 2009. Authorities believe foul play was involved in the disappearance of Harold Schroetter (pictured below) and he is now believed to be deceased. Extensive investigation by the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension staff have been unable locate Schroetter, but they were able to find Schroetter's blood in the trunk of his girlfriends car for which a new trunk liner had been purchased and replaced shortly after Schroetter's disappearance.

The family and friends of Harold Schroetter want to bring closure to this sad and mysterious by bringing the killer(s) to justice. Through a special

arrangement with the Spotlight on Crime Fund created by Minnesota businesses and public safety officials a reward of up to \$50,000 is being offered for information that leads to an arrest and charging in this case.
